# MARRIAGE: All God's Idea

#### **Genesis 2:18-25** (ESV)

- **18** Then the Lord God said, "It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him a helper fit for him."
- 19 Now out of the ground the Lord God had formed every beast of the field and every bird of the heavens and brought them to the man to see what he would call them. And whatever the man called every living creature, that was its name.
- 20 The man gave names to all livestock and to the birds of the heavens and to every beast of the field. But for Adam there was not found a helper fit for him. 21 So the Lord God caused a deep sleep to fall upon the man, and while he slept took one of his ribs and closed up its place with flesh.
- 22 And the rib that the Lord God had taken from the man he made into a woman and brought her to the man. 23 Then the man said.

"This at last is bone of my bones and flesh of my flesh; she shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man."

24 Therefore a man shall leave his father and his mother and hold fast to his wife, and they shall become one flesh. 25 And the man and his wife were both naked and were not ashamed.

#### I. FOUNDATIONAL BASIS: Marriage is God's Doing.

# A) Marriage was God's Design.

Genesis 1:27-28 No other creature was <u>suitable</u>. (2:19-20) The woman was the <u>specially designed</u> fit.

### B) God gave away the first Bride.

Genesis 2:22 — and brought her to the man

## C) God spoke the marriage design into existence.

Genesis 2:24

Therefore a man shall leave his father and his mother and hold fast to his wife, and they shall become one flesh.

Jesus believed Genesis... Luke 24:44 writer is Moses. But, Matthew 19:4-5 reveals that <u>God</u> is the one speaking in Genesis 2:24 recorded by Moses.

# D) God <u>performs</u> the marriage or '<u>one-flesh union</u>'.

Genesis 2:24— and they shall become one flesh
God made woman. (vs 21) God made marriage. (vs 24)

Implicit in Genesis 2:24

Explicit in Mark 10:8-9

8 and the two shall become one flesh.' So they are no longer two but one flesh. 9 What therefore <u>God has joined together</u>, let not man separate."

God is the <u>joiner</u>, not husband and wife. Not understanding this leads to <u>casual commitment</u>.

#### II. ULTIMATE PURPOSE: Marriage is for God's Glory.

Connect Genesis 2:24 with Ephesians 5:31-31 Ephesians 5:31-32

31 "Therefore a man shall leave his father and mother and hold fast to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh." 32 This mystery is profound, and I am saying that it refers to Christ and the church.

Human relationships are designed by God to be a <u>reflection</u> of our relationship with God. And they are not merely an image but a <u>reality</u>.

Marriage is patterned after Christ's <u>covenant</u> <u>commitment</u> to the Church.

Christ is the <u>bride-groom</u>; the Church is the <u>bride</u>. (Matthew 9:15; 25:1; John 3:29; 2 Cor 11:2)

Christ would forever secure His <u>bride</u> through His <u>blood</u>. Luke 22:20 — His oath, His covenant, His blood

God gave marriage to show us His love and glory.

#### **Matthew 19:4-5**

4 He answered, "Have you not read that <u>he who created them</u> from the beginning made them male and female, 5 <u>and said</u>, 'Therefore a man shall leave his father and his mother and hold fast to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh'?
