ISAIAH 46

English Standard Version ESV

- 1** *Bel bows down; Nebo stoops;
their idols are on beasts and livestock;
these things you carry are borne
as burdens on weary beasts.*
- 2** *They stoop; they bow down together;
they cannot save the burden,
but themselves go into captivity.*
- 3** *"Listen to me, O house of Jacob,
all the remnant of the house of Israel,
who have been borne by me from before your birth,
carried from the womb;*
- 4** *even to your old age I am he,
and to gray hairs I will carry you.
I have made, and I will bear;
I will carry and will save.*
- 5** *"To whom will you liken me and make me equal,
and compare me, that we may be alike?*
- 6** *Those who lavish gold from the purse,
and weigh out silver in the scales,
hire a goldsmith, and he makes it into a god;
then they fall down and worship!*
- 7** *They lift it to their shoulders, they carry it,
they set it in its place, and it stands there;
it cannot move from its place.
If one cries to it, it does not answer
or save him from his trouble.*
- 8** *"Remember this and stand firm,
recall it to mind, you transgressors,*
- 9** *remember the former things of old;
for I am God, and there is no other;
I am God, and there is none like me,*
- 10** *declaring the end from the beginning
and from ancient times things not yet done,
saying, 'My counsel shall stand,
and I will accomplish all my purpose,'*
- 11** *calling a bird of prey from the east,
the man of my counsel from a far country.
I have spoken, and I will bring it to pass;
I have purposed, and I will do it.*
- 12** *"Listen to me, you stubborn of heart,
you who are far from righteousness:*
- 13** *I bring near my righteousness; it is not far off,
and my salvation will not delay;
I will put salvation in Zion,
for Israel my glory."*

Deuteronomy 12:2-3

You shall surely destroy all the places where the nations whom you shall dispossess served their gods, on the high mountains and on the hills and under every green tree. You shall tear down their altars and dash in pieces their pillars and burn their Asherim with fire. You shall chop down the carved images of their gods and destroy their name out of that place.

Deuteronomy 7:5

But thus shall you deal with them: you shall break down their altars and dash in pieces their pillars and chop down their Asherim and burn their carved images with fire.

Ezekiel 30:13

"Thus says the Lord God: "I will destroy the idols and put an end to the images in Memphis; there shall no longer be a prince from the land of Egypt; so I will put fear in the land of Egypt.

Isaiah 2:17-18

And the haughtiness of man shall be humbled, and the lofty pride of men shall be brought low, and the Lord alone will be exalted in that day. And the idols shall utterly pass away.
