
COLOSSIANS 3:5-10

6)	Notice that Jesus (the Creator-Savior God) is warning you of vs 43-48 The world and even much of 'Christianity' may be in denial about the reality of hell, but Gehenna (hell) appears times in the NT times used by Christ. Jesus calls us to either deal radically with our sin or be cast into the pit of hell the outer darkness (Matthew 8:12) the furnace of fire (Matthew 13:42) where there will be a weeping and gnashing of teeth (Matthew 22:13) The truly saved will with their sin.
