1 PETER 2:3-9

English Standard Version (ESV)

4 As you come to him, a living stone rejected by men but in the sight of God chosen and precious, 5 you yourselves like living stones are being built up as a spiritual house, to be a holy priesthood, to offer spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ. **6** For it stands in Scripture: "Behold, I am laying in Zion a stone, Isaiah 28:16 a cornerstone chosen and precious, and whoever believes in him will not be put to shame." **7** So the honor is for you who believe, but for those who do not believe, "The stone that the builders rejected Psalm 118:22 has become the cornerstone," 8 and "A stone of stumbling, Isaiah 8:14-15 and a rock of offense." They stumble because they disobey the word, as they were destined to do. 9 But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light. 10 Once you were not a people, but now you are God's people; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy. 11 Beloved, I urge you as sojourners and exiles to abstain from the passions of the

flesh, which wage war against your soul. **12** Keep your conduct among the Gentiles honorable, so that when they speak against you as evildoers, they may see your good

deeds and glorify God on the day of visitation.

REVIEW & CONTEXT:

- 1) The Apostle Peter, was one of the closest disciples to Jesus who initially failed many times, but after being filled with the Holy Spirit at Pentecost he was a bold and effective preacher and leader for the early church.
- 2) Several years after Christ ascended to heaven and the Holy Spirit had come to fill God's people, Peter writes to first century believers who were being persecuted. His letter is also to all followers of Jesus who live in a sinful world that is hostile to the ways of God.
- 3) In chapter 1, Peter seeks to lift up their eyes to their great _____ through Jesus Christ. Though rejected by the world, they are _____ and <u>saved</u> by God.
- 4) Most recent message in ch 2: YOU ARE THE HOUSE OF GOD made up of ______ stones into a spiritual house where Christ is the CORNERSTONE.

Did God still use them?

Peter draws from God's terminology in the Old Testament...

DEUTERONOMY 7:6-8

6 "For you are a people holy to the Lord your God. The Lord your God has chosen you to be a people for his treasured possession, out of all the peoples who are on the face of the earth. 7 It was not because you were more in number than any other people that the Lord **set his love on you and chose you**, for you were the fewest of all peoples, 8 but it is because the Lord loves you and is keeping the oath that he swore to your fathers, that the Lord has brought you out with a mighty hand and redeemed you from the house of slavery, from the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt. 9 Know therefore that the Lord your God is God, the faithful God who keeps covenant and steadfast love with those who love him and keep his commandments, to a thousand generations."

Peter wants Christians to remember and understand that just as God chose Israel for a special purpose in His redemptive plan, so He has also chosen them through His own sovereign, electing purpose and will. (See John 15:16; Acts 13:48; Romans 9:13-16; 11:5; 1 Corinthians 1:9; Ephesians 1:3-5; 1 Thessalonians 1:4; 2 Thessalonians 2:13-14; 2 Timothy 1:9; 2:10; Revelation 13:8; 17:8; 20:15 — also see our sermon & handout THE BEAUTIFUL DOCTRINE OF DIVINE ELECTION)

4)	You are a HOLY NATION: vs 9
	' holy ' (ἄγιον or <i>hagios</i>) literally means '
	Again, remember Exodus 19:6 'and you shall be to me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation.' While God brought His messiah into the world through Israel, we now see that ALL the truly redeemed make up not just a special earthly nation but a heavenly spiritual nation. This is God's holy nation that Peter speaks of both Jews and (non-Jews) who recognize Jesus as the Messiah of God.
	This does not negate God's special plan for the He still is at work in them.
5)	You are a <u>PEOPLE FOR GOD'S OWN</u> : vs 9
	This is an often repeated term for God's people (Exodus 19:5; Deut 7:6-7; 14:2; 26:18; Mal. 3:17).
	' possession ' (περιποίησιν or <i>peripoiēsin</i>) literally means '
	Believers belong to God because he bought them for an (1 Peter 1:18-19; 1 Cor. 6:20; 7:23; Hebrews 13:12; Revelation 5:9)
	This points to the ultimate plan of God in heaven — when and are finished.
