 *“Worthy are you to take the scroll
 and to open its seals,
 for you were slain, and by your blood you ransomed people for God
 from every tribe and language and people and nation,*
10 *and you have made them a kingdom and priests to our God,
 and they shall reign on the earth.”*
11 Then I looked, and I heard around the throne and the living creatures and
 the elders the voice of many angels, numbering myriads of myriads and
 thousands of thousands, 12 saying with a loud voice,
 *“Worthy is the Lamb who was slain,
 to receive power and wealth and wisdom and might
 and honor and glory and blessing!”*
13 And I heard every creature in heaven and on earth and under the earth and
 in the sea, and all that is in them, saying,
 *“To Him who sits on the throne and to the Lamb

GENESIS 12:1-3

1 Now the Lord said to Abram, “Go from your country and your kindred and your father’s house to the land that I will show you. 2 And I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you and make your name great, so that you will be a blessing. 3 I will bless those who bless you, and him who dishonors you I will curse, and in you **all the families of the earth shall be blessed.**”

Not just a personal blessing. But covenantal, redemptive and _____.

GALATIANS 3:8 The Apostle Paul references this...

And the Scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, preached the gospel beforehand to Abraham, saying, “In you shall all the nations be blessed.”

God, Himself, reiterates this specific promise in Genesis 18:18 and 22:18.
The promise was *not* Israel alone, *not* one culture, *not* one language but _____.

God's sovereign _____ of Abraham was the path of blessing to the nations.
